

CULVERT PERMIT: It is important to have the proper drainage of the ditches along parish roads. A culvert permit is required in order to insure that property owners purchase the correct size for their roadside ditches. The process for obtaining this permit is as follows:

Upon completion of the highlighted areas of the attached form, please submit for approval. Once received, we will contact you via email or phone with the size of the culvert needed. Property owners are responsible for the purchase of the culverts. The Police Jury will set one per individual property owner. We ask that you flag the area on each end where you would like the culvert to be set. You may purchase metal, plastic, or concrete culverts.

Developers and businesses will be required to acquire a permit but will have to set themselves.

If this is deemed a job for the Road Crew, we ask that you call or e-mail when the culvert is physically on your property and ready to be installed. This will generate a work order for those to be set by the Police Jury and will be put on a work schedule to be completed in a timely manner.

There is no cost for this permit.

For State Highways, you will need to contact Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development.

- 4. No culvert will be installed if less than 15" in diameter and 20' in length.
- 5. Applicant will notify Public Works Office when culvert is at proposed site.
- 6. Installation of culvert will then be scheduled.
