RESOLUTION NO. 29-2017

WHEREAS, the Rural Solid Waste Tax Proposition in Sales Tax District No. 1 of the Parish of Beauregard was initially approved Saturday, January 19, 1991, and further renewed for 10 additional years beginning April 1, 1996, and ending April 1, 2006; and further renewed April 1, 2006 and ending April 1, 2016 and further renewed April 1, 2016 and ending April 1, 2026.

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the tax are to pay all reasonable & necessary expenses of collecting and administering the tax and for paying all cost related to collecting and disposing of Solid Waste in the un-incorporated part of the parish, known as Sales Tax District 1; and

WHEREAS, the cash balance of \$3,713,267.01 remaining in Solid Waste Sales Tax Account #31 at year-end 2016 is sufficient to meet a transfer of \$600,000.00 into the work zones.

WHEREAS, all funds remaining at year-end after all Tax Collection cost and Solid Waste Collection and Disposal cost are paid can be transferred in equal amounts to the six work zones as established under the parish unit system in the ensuing fiscal year as stated in the proposition for the purpose of constructing, improving and maintaining public roads.

WHEREAS, the proposition(s) allows the collection of 1% Sales Tax upon the sale of retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption and storage for use or consumption, of tangible personal property and on sales of services in the District, all as presently defined in LA. R. S. 47:301 through 47:317 for a period of five (5) years from April 1, 1991 and further renewed as levied in Ordinance No. 3-95 Special Election, Saturday, July 15, 1995 effective April 1, 1996 for a period of ten (10) years, which allows for available revenues to be split between the eight wards, and further voted on November 12, 2005 for renewal April 1, 2006 and ending April 1, 2016, which allows for the available revenues collected to be split equally between the six work zones, and further voted on March 5, 2016 for renewal April 1, 2016 and ending April 1, 2026, which allows for the available revenues collected to be split equally between the six work zones.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Beauregard, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority") of the Sales Tax District No. 1 of the Parish of Beauregard, State of Louisiana (the "District"), acting as the governing authority of the District that a total of \$600,000 be transferred out of the Solid Waste Sales Tax District Account into each respective work zones as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1-2017

REAFFIRMING VOTING PRECINCTS
FOR BEAUREGARD PARISH, LOUISIANA,
FOR ALL PURPOSES

WHEREFORE, the Police Jury of Beauregard Parish, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, acting as the governing body of said parish, in accordance with law, has previously established voting precincts for said parish, by provisions of Ordinance 1-97, Resolution 5-97, Ordinance 8-14-2002, Ordinance 1-2002, as amended, Resolution 44-2002, Resolution 83-2003, Resolution 18-2004, Ordinance 2-2004, and Ordinance 4-2004 as amended, and Ordinance 4-2014,

WHEREFORE, under the provisions of LSA-R.S. 18:532, et seq, precincts containing less than 300 registered voters should be merged, if possible, with other precincts; and,

WHEREFORE, the Police Jury deems it desirable that all voting precinct descriptions should be contained in one Ordinance;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that in accordance with the provisions of law of the State of Louisiana, the Beauregard Parish Police Jury, herewith amends all prior Ordinances and Ordinance 4-2014, and changes (1) voting precinct to be used for all purposes in said parish, said changed voting precinct to be as follows:

Precinct 21 – Bundick Lake Fire Station–Hopewell Community, 4924 Hwy 394, Deridder, LA 70634

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the description of said voting precincts, and polling places designated therefore, shall be as described hereinafter, and, further that the descriptions of all voting precincts for Beauregard Parish shall be as restated herein, to wit:

PRECINCT 1: Hyatt Community Ctr, 6249 Highway 109, Fields, LA 70653

Beginning at the southwest corner of the Beauregard Parish boundary line and the intersection with the center flow channel of the Sabine River, thence proceed first easterly then northerly along the Beauregard Parish and Calcasieu Parish boundary line to the intersection with LA Hwy 389; thence proceed first westerly then northerly on said highway to the intersection with South Bearhead Road; thence proceed northerly along said road to its intersection with A. Williams Road; thence proceed easterly on said road to the intersection with Pickering Road, thence proceed northerly on Pickering Road to the intersection with Old Seale Road; thence proceed easterly on said road to the intersection with Burns Clark Road, thence proceed northeasterly on Burns Clark Road to the intersection with LA Hwy 109, thence proceed westerly on LA Hwy 109 to the intersection with John Harville Road, thence proceed northerly on John Harville Road to the intersection with an unnamed road in Section 27, Township 5 South, Range 11 West, thence proceed first northerly then northwesterly on said road to the intersection with an unnamed unimproved road in Section 9 Township 5 South, Range 11 West, thence proceed first northwesterly then westerly on said road to the intersection with an unnamed improved road in Section 11, Township 5 South, Range 12 West, thence proceed first southerly, westerly then southerly on said road to the intersection with another unnamed unimproved road in Section 34, Township 5 South, Range 12 West, thence proceed first westerly then southerly on said road to the intersection with an unnamed unimproved road in Section 4, Township 6 South, Range 12 West, thence proceed easterly on said road to the intersection with an unnamed improved road in Section 3, Township 6 South, Range 12 West, thence proceed first southwesterly then southerly on said road to the intersection with LA Hwy 389, thence proceed westerly on LA Hwy 389 to the intersection with the Old River Road, thence proceed southerly on the Old River Road to the intersection with the center flow channel of Caney Creek, thence proceed westerly along the center flow channel of Caney Creek to the intersection with the center flow channel of the Sabine River, thence proceed southerly along the center flow channel of the Sabine River to the southwest corner of the Beauregard Parish boundary line, which is the point of beginning.

PRECINCT 2: Police Jury Storage Yard, 338 Spikes Cemetery Road, Merryville, LA 70653

Beginning at the intersection of the Texas/Louisiana Stateline and Brushy Creek, then north on Brushy Creek to its intersection with Caney Creek, then east on Caney Creek to its intersection with Parish Road 60, then north on Parish Road 60 to its intersection with State Route 389, then east on State Route 389 to its intersection with a local road .65 miles east of Bill Doyle Road, then north for .17 miles the road to its intersection with a local road, then north, west, north, east and north for 8.17 miles on a local road north of Brushy Creek west for 1.6 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .48 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then north for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west for .27 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .30 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west and northwest for 1.1 miles on the road to its intersection with State Route 389, then northeast on State Route 389 to its intersection with Fishhole Loop, then northwest on Fishhole Loop to its intersection with Dump Road, then west and southwest on Dump Road to its intersection with Rattlesnake Slough, then south and west on Rattlesnake Slough to its intersection with Texas/Louisiana Stateline, then south to the point of beginning

PRECINCT 3: Bivens Fire Station, 5163 LA Highway 389, Merryville, LA 70653

Beginning at the intersection of the Texas/Louisiana Stateline and the AT & SF Railway, then east on the railway to its intersection with the corporate limits of Merryville, then south, east and north on the corporate limits to its intersection with Parish Road 33, then east on Parish Road 33 to its intersection with a local road 1.3 miles east of Arco Road, then south, west and south on the road to its intersection with State Route 110, then northwest on State Route 110 to its intersection with a local road .6 miles northwest of Baywood Drive., then southwest on the road to its intersection with Bivens Oil Field Road, then west for 2.6 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .65 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west for .74 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road north of Brushy Creek, then west for 1.6 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .48 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then north for .5 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west for .27 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then south for .30 miles on the road to its intersection with a local road, then west and northwest for 1.1 miles on the road to its intersection with State Route 389, then northeast on State Route 389 to its intersection with Fishhole Loop, then northwest on Fishhole Loop to its intersection with Dump Road, then west and southwest on Dump Road to its intersection with Rattlesnake Slough, then south and west on Rattlesnake Slough to its intersection with Texas/Louisiana Stateline, then north to the point of beginning.

PRECINCT 4: Merryville Community Center, 3024 South Pine Street, Merryville, LA 70653

All of that area lying within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Merryville, Louisiana.

PRECINCT 5: Fire Station, 272 Mouth of the Creek Road, Junction, LA 70653

Beginning at the intersection of the center flow channel of the Sabine River and the Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railroad, thence proceed easterly on said railroad to the intersection with the corporate boundary of the Town of Merryville, thence proceed along said corporate boundary first northerly, easterly then southerly to the intersection with Neal Oil Field Road, thence proceed easterly on said road to the intersection with Arco Road, thence proceed first northerly then easterly on Arco Road to the intersection with Oil Field Cutoff Road, thence proceed northerly on said road to the intersection with A. W. Sibley Road, thence proceed easterly on said road the intersection with Lum Nichols Road, thence proceed northeasterly on said road to the intersection with Libick Road, thence proceed northeasterly on said road to the intersection with U.S. Hwy 190, thence proceed westerly on U.S. Hwy 190 to the intersection with Bob Coursey Road, thence proceed northerly on said road to the intersection with Ferris Loop, thence proceed westerly on Ferris Loop to the intersection with an unidentified unimproved road in Section 26, Township 2 South, Range 11

West, thence proceed northerly on said road to the intersection with the center flow channel of Bayou Anacoco (which is also the Beauregard Parish and Vernon Parish boundary line), thence proceed westerly along the center flow channel of Bayou Anacoco to the intersection with the center flow channel of the Sabine River, thence proceed southerly along the center flow channel of the Sabine River to the intersection with the Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railroad, which is the point of beginning.

PRECINCT 6: Cooper Building, 6258 U.S. Hwy 190 West, DeRidder, LA 70634

Beginning at the intersection of Neal Oil Field Road and Arco Road in Section 33, Township 3 South, Range 11 West, thence proceed easterly on Neal Oil Field Road to the intersection with Pujo Road, thence proceed northerly on Pujo Road to the intersection with Graybow Road, thence proceed northeasterly on Graybow Road to the intersection with a private railroad in Section 15, Township 3 South, Range 10 West, thence proceed northerly on said private railroad to the intersection with a private road in Section 27, Township 2 South, Range 10 West, thence proceed first easterly then northerly on said private road, (which is the boundary of the west side of the Boise-Cascade paper mill), to the intersection with the Beauregard Parish and Vernon Parish boundary line, thence proceed westerly along the Beauregard Parish and Vernon Parish boundary line to the intersection with the center flow channel of Bayou Anacoco, thence proceed southwesterly along the center flow channel of said bayou to the intersection with an unimproved, unidentified road in Section 26, Township 2 South, Range 11 West, thence proceed southerly on said unidentified road to the intersection with Ferris Loop, thence proceed easterly on Ferris Loop, to the intersection with Bob Coursey Road, thence proceed southerly on Bob Coursey Road to the intersection with U.S. Hwy 190, thence proceed easterly on said road to the intersection with Libick Road, thence proceed southerly on Libick Road to the intersection with Lum Nichols Road, thence proceed southwesterly on Lum Nichols Road to the intersection with A. W. Sibley Road, thence proceed westerly on said road to the intersection with Oil Field Cut Off Road, thence proceed southerly on said road to the intersection with Arco Road, thence proceed first westerly then southerly on Arco Road to the intersection with Neal Oil Field Road, which is the point of beginning.

PRECINCT 7: Planer Mill Fire Station, 2061 Bilbo Street, DeRidder, LA 70634
