Permit Requirements for electrical service for structures that **contain** plumbing are: 911 Permit, Sewer Permit and Floodplain Management Permit

**Please Note:** To apply for a Sewer Permit and a Floodplain Management Permit, applicants will need to supply a copy of a legal land description for the proposed site. (This may be obtained from the Tax Assessors office-contact information follows).

# **BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL STRUCTURES**

## **RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL STRUCTURES THAT REQUIRE BUILDING PERMITS:**

- New Construction
- Building Relocations
- Additions
- Extensive Remodels
- Modular Structures
- Park Model Manufactured Homes

## **REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN A BUILDING PERMIT:**

After obtaining a 911 Address Permit, Sewer Permit and Floodplain Development Permit you can continue the Building Permit process by supplying the Beauregard Parish Police Jury Permit Department with the following:

A set of plans or blueprints that will be retained by the Parish Building Official

Permit Fees are based on individual projects and will be determined by the Parish Permit Technician. These fees are to be paid by; Cashier Check, Money Order, Building Account or Business Account. All methods of payment are to be issued to the "Beauregard Parish Police Jury".

A Building Permit Application will be completed. At which time the permit fee will be collected and along with a set of plans or blueprints will be supplied the Parish Building Code Inspector to complete the required Plan Review. This review will be submitted to the permit technician and you will be notified to return to the permit office to sign the plan review and you will be issued your Building Permit and Building Placard.
