Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Beauregard Parish Police Jury Mitigation Strategy

Beauregard Parish, Louisiana – Recommendations from the health community continues to be very dynamic, our decisions are guided by the CDC and designed to be protective of our staff and citizenry.
